

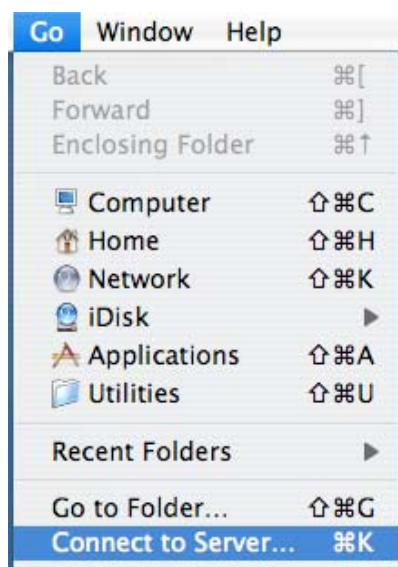


Connecting to LRDC's Windows 2003 Server Using Mac OS X

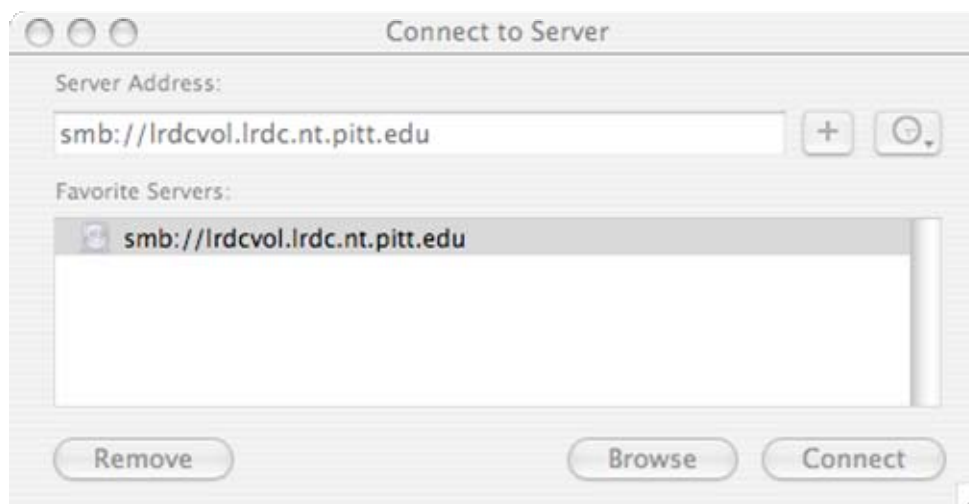

You may access the LRDC Windows 2003 file servers by following the steps below.

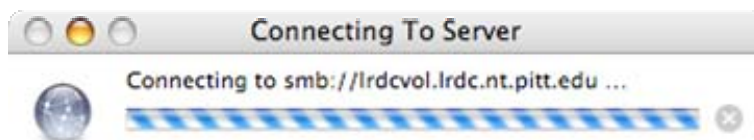
- 1 With the Finder selected, Choose “**Connect to server...**” from the **Go** menu.



- 2 Type **smb://lrdcvol.lrdc.nt.pitt.edu**



- 3 We recommend adding your server as a Favorite to expedite the process each time you wish to connect. To add your server as a favorite, press the + button. (Note: You only need to add the server to your favorites once.)
- 4 Press **Connect** to connect to the server.



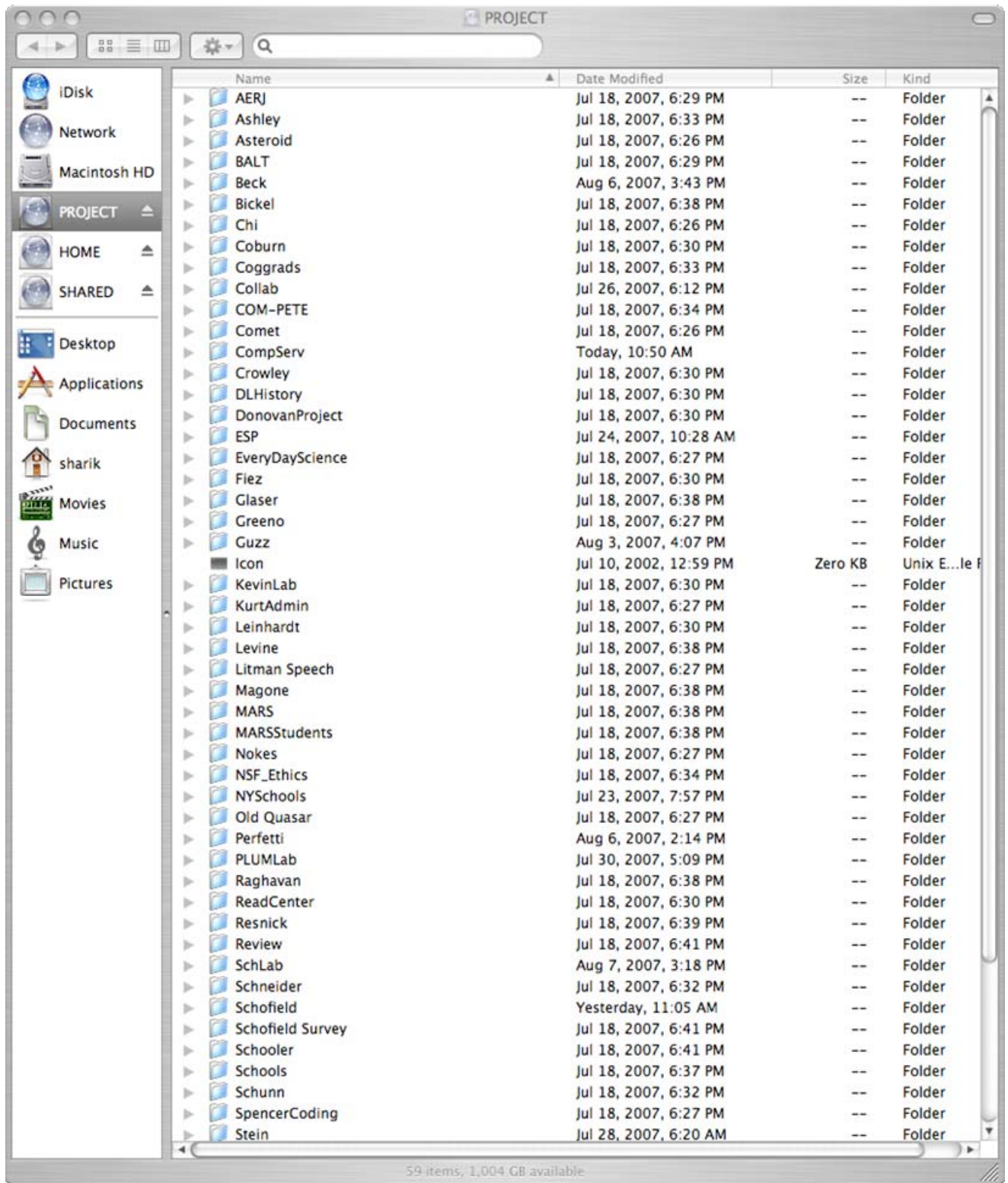
- 5 Type your username and password to authenticate with your server. [Note: If you are using OS 10.4.x and click “Remember this password in my keychain,” your login information will be saved and you will not be prompted to login each time you connect. This feature does not work with operating systems prior to 10.4]



- 6 Select the share that you would like to connect to by clicking on the arrow. **Home** contains your personal folder that only you have access to. **Project** contains your group folder(s) where you can share files with members of your project(s). **Shared** contains your public folder that allows anyone at LRDC to see your files—great for sharing files between users.



- 7 You are now connected to your server’s share, which will appear on both your Desktop and in any folder Window. In order to connect to a different share, repeat the process above. Please note that you may be connected to multiple shares at the same time.
